

Masjid Ibrahim is based in Southern River, Perth, Australia. Established with the intention of serving the local and global Muslim community in various capacities, it currently consists of a Masjid which can accommodate 275 patrons for 5 times daily prayer, a female area, and kitchen space.

Since its humble inception, Masjid Ibrahim has grown in leaps and bounds hosting many local and foreign 'ulama and visitors, conducting various programs including a provision for ramdān 'itikāf, activities for different sectors of our community and providing community services – all without compromise and within the confines of the teaching of our dīn.

Masjid Report:


Imams:

The Masjid currently employs 3 full time Imams:

Islamic Marriages and Nikah's:

Islamic Marriages and Nikah's are regularly conducted – with one of the Imam's being a registered marriage celebrant, this service can also be accessed.



Ramadān:

Ramadān is a hub of activity with many guest 'ulama and reciters having visited over the years. Post fajr, pre-iftar halaqāt, programs for the sisters, and post tarāwīh tafsir sessions are regular features.

Weekends offer additional programs. A sunnah inspired daily iftār is offered through the 'sponsor an iftār' program.

The last 10 days of ramadān is usually abuzz with those in 'itikāf with a full on daily schedule. A dedicated team of volunteers work tirelessly to ensure smooth operations during ramadān.



A carefully prepared ramadān timetable is also prepared as well Zakah Nisāb and Sadagah al-Fitr calculations in consultation with mutlple 'ulama.

For Ramadān 1445/2024 Dr Mufti Abdur Rahman Mangera once again honoured us with his presence for the last 10 nights.

Janazah Prayers:

At the moment, janazah prayers for the deceased are conducted at the Masjid upon request. The future building expansion project will house a bathing and shrouding facility.

Open Days:

Regular masjid open days are held which gives the opportunity to engage with the broader community.

The above services are provided by the Masjid where the udhiyyah and Qurbani is overseen by 'ulama in multiple countries.

Haj Workshops:

Annual haj workshops are held for intending Hujjaj with the multiple 'Ulama and scholars presenting.



Darul Uloom Masjid Ibrahim:

Darul Uloom started some 13 years ago. The Darul Uloom has a total of 64 students and 9 teachers including part time teachers.

Currently It offers the following programs:

Hifz al Quran Program:

A total of 48 students and 4 hifz teachers make up this program.

34 part time students who attend school going days from 6am - 8am

14 Full time students who attend 2 sessions daily: 6am – 12:10pm

Home Schooling registration is mandatory for this program. There is also Islamic studies and tarbiyyah sessions offered to the Hifz al Quran students.

Alim Graduate Program:

Covering a traditional curriculum over 7 years the content covers in depth Arabic language, aqīdah, tafsīr, Qirā'ah, hadīth and fiqh studies.


Daily classes are from 7:30am - 12:10pm

All the above classes are housed at the Masjid.



To date:

- Thus far 13 students have completed the memorisation of the Quran with 1 more completing today. One student completed last month.
- 5 students have completed and received ijazah in the riwayah of hafs.
- 5 students have graduated as 'ulama. Of these, 1 has graduated as a Mufti. 1 serves as Imam in Masjid Ibrahim. 1 serves as Imam in Sakinah Islamic Centre. 2 have established Dar al-Quran in Henley Brook.
- 4 students will graduate today.
- New student intake is open for 2025. Application form is available on the Masjid website (www.masjidibrahim.com.au).



2 Year Islamic ISCP – Islamic Studies Certificate Professional

A unique program structured for professionals and businessman and those interested in learning dīn but don't have time at their disposal for a 7 year Aalim program. Began in 2023 after ramadān, it is modularized over 2 years and conveniently run between 6:45am - 8:15, Mon - Thurs.

This program covers the basics of Arabic language and gradually introduce Quran translation, Tajwid, Tafsir, Hadith and Fiqh and enough to give a grounded understanding of the foundations of the dīn.

Maktab Ibrahim:

Maktab Report Mach 2024:

Office:

The Maktab is overseen by the Principal, Shaykh Abubakr, who also serves as one of the educators.

Administration support is provided by an office administrator.

Student Roll:

Maktab has seen a steady increase in student numbers. At the end of 2014, we had 93 students. Current (2024) cohort totals 340.

Maktab caters for students ranging from 6 to 16 with Saturday classes catering for older students. Gender segregation is an ethos of the Masjid and all it's programs and its staff complement. From Year 3 onwards total segregation between males and females is implemented with only male teachers teaching the males and females teaching the females.

Teachers:

Maktab has a complement of 24 full time teachers, this is complemented by 6 relief teachers.

There are 6 male teachers and 18 female teachers, who serve on a full-time basis.







Maktab runs 25 classes, ranging from the Beginner Level to Senior Girls.

Beginner classes to Class 9 are held fulltime, 5 days per week, from 4:30pm to 6:15pm. Most levels comprise 2 classes with classrooms accommodating 20 students on average.

Students are separated by gender from Class 3 onwards.

Maktab holds classes for Class 10 students (male & female 16 to 18 years), as well as university students (females only), on Saturday mornings from 9am to 10:30am.

Syllabi:

Maktab has a structured program covering both Quran recital and Islamic Studies. Tasheel Series is the series of choice and covers creed and belief, history, hadith memorisation, figh and jurisprudence, akhlāq and character development.

Assesments:

Formal assessments are conducted biannually, at the of Terms 2 & 4. A parent-teacher meeting, held shortly after the Term 2 assessments, serves as a valuable feedback mechanism to communicate individual student progress.

Written reports are prepared for students at the end of the year.

Social Responsibility / Maktab Activities:

At various times throughout the year and when the need arises, students and teachers engage in community and charitable fundraisers. Examples of events include the Turkey/Syria Earthquake Bakesale (on Fri, 03.03), Suleymaniye (Turkish) Masjid Fundraiser (for the damage induced by inclement weather), etc.

Day events are held annually. In 2024, students participated in sports day, competed in Islamic quiz competitions, and partook and contributed to Sunnah meal events.

An annual Jalsah / Awards Day serves as an educational showcase to highlight the progress and achievements of our students.

Future building and carpark:

As part of the expansion project of the educational vision of all our programs and facilities:

- Stage One of car park has been completed. Stage Two will begin once ground works in place.
- A new building block which will house new classrooms, admin facilities, a library, a janazah bathing and shrouding facility and a multi-purpose student space.
